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<b>Course title:</b>	<b>English language for teachers – “How to talk and teach about Europe”</b>
<b>Course description:</b>	<p>This is a specifically designed course for teachers of all subjects as well as English language teachers who want to improve their own English language skills and upgrade their lessons by implementing new pedagogical ideas, learning methods and knowledge in the field of European studies.</p> <p>This course aims to give participants a basic knowledge of reading, listening, spoken and written skills in a dynamic and communicative way, through individual, pair and group work. There will also be a lecture and possibility to converse with the expert. The unique element of this training course are the activities carried outdoors in Kraków – UNESCO heritage site. While sightseeing with a professional tour guide participants will have the opportunity to learn about European heritage, our culture roots, history, unknown facts, architecture, migrations and many others. During reflection sessions there will be time to exchange opinion and develop own point of view and teaching ideas. Thanks to this training participants will both increase their English language skills and learn how to talk and teach about Europe in a more professional way.</p>
